- Discussion on **Supplemental Kindergarten-**
 - Canyon View will be offering a full day Kindergarten
 - This is not a state funded program
 - Tuition based program
 - Test scores show that full day kindergarten can boost scores in the future
 - This could help with intervention in the higher grades in the future, we wouldn't have to spend as much with intervention aides
 - First come first serve application
 - Scholarship slots available
 - \$300 a month- if you pay upfront you get 10% (prices from last year)
 - Parents will have a choice
 - Will we have enough to support this program (at least 14 paying patrons)
 - Anyone can apply to show interest but they don't need to commit right when they apply- This will be a district application
 - Specifics will be decided such as transportation, lunch schedules etc.

- Fifth Grade: Fall- 62% proficient, Winter 69% Proficient. Our goal is 80%
- Fourth Grade: Fall 44% Proficient, Winter 68% Proficient
- DORF- Oral Reading Fluency
- Third Grade: Words Correct: 77%-76%
- Third Grade: Accuracy- 83%-90%
- Second Grade: Words Correct- 78%-81%
- Second Grade Accuracy: 79%-81%
- First Grade testing has changed since kindergarten
- Teachers focus more on phonemic awareness to help students break down words
- Words Correct: 71%
- Accuracy 69%
- Kindergarten-10% increase in proficiency (78%-88%)
- Testing includes breaking down words ex. Cat=c-a-t
- Nonsense words to demonstrate phonemic awareness
- School- Wide: 78% proficient- We are making progress as a school but this data is too general to get specific information
- Students also take DWSBA test which are District Wide Standards Based Assessment
- This test helps students on SAGE test which helps prepare them for middle school
- It is more problem based test which prepares them more
- If students are doing well on their DWSBA test, they are doing well on the Dibels tests

Math

- DIBELS Computation- Math Facts
- DIBELS Concepts and Application- Use facts to solve problems
- Composite scores- Fall to Winter
- 4th grade 76%- 83%
- 3rd grade 55%-74%
- 2nd grade 33%- 72%
- 1st grade 59%-74%
- Teachers can use DATA to help each individual student improve
