**Business:**

- Lunch Recess Considerations
  - Should we switch our schedule as it was before?
  - Parent Concern: Hand washing is more effective than hand sanitizing.
  - Did the students actually wash their hands in the previous system?
  - We don't feel that handwashing is a big enough deal to change the lunch schedule
  - We like how with reverse lunch our kids are actually taking time to eat lunch which is more important
  - We see there are more benefits to our system this year, we don't want to change it
  - If students feel the need to wash their hands they have the option to do it
  - Maybe we can use hand washing station
  - Hand wipes can also be a good alternative
  - Now we have good feedback
- Review of Emergency/Incident Command Processes
  - Our young students practice the drills with us but do not know why. We teach them why this would happen at a more developed age
  - There are some door jams that can help our students be safe

- Our doors are always locked but there is a magnet to not close the door all the way. This is a safety measure that we have done to prepare
- One challenge that we have faced is not having a radio for our teachers on recess duty. We have purchased a Motorola radios for each grade level which will help the teachers during recess duty
- We have a manual that goes into more detail about what our drills are
- We have secured a location at the closest LDS church
- We needed a little safety review after all the recent current events

**Action Items:**

- DWSBA Data Review
  - Our goal is that 80% of the students are at proficiency level
  - Our writing scores are much lower than our Math scores but we are new to writing these
  - We are doing more trainings on how to incorporate more writing in other subjects
  - What data do the different assessments give us?
  - This data shows that what we need to focus on
  - This is a great tool for use to use as educators
- Discussion of the CSIP goals for 2018 – 2019
  - 80% mastery on the different tests, DWSBA, PBIS and DIBELS.
  - Our goal is in progress and we are making progress
  - We should keep it the same as last year
  - Next time we meet we will have a rough draft
