LAND TRUST BUDGET UPDATE-

Are there other ways to assess students than tests? Yes- teachers are always using informal ways to assess where students level of understanding is at. Then they work with students in small group instruction to re-teach concepts.

There will be adjustments to PBIS Goals for next year. We just started Morning Meetings with students to help develop more social skills. Four components to the Morning Meetings. By May we will have all four parts integrated into the day.

Discussion that keeping our plan similar to what it has been. We would like to hire an additional math interventionist. BJ would like to hire a behavior aide also.

OTHER BUSINESS-

Vicky Crocheron was hired for 2nd grade to replace Kellie Molis after leaving mid-year. Supplemental Kindergarten will be expanding this coming year within the district. More schools will be offering it.
