Business:

Land Trust update and review plan for 2016/2017

Mr. Weller submitted the plan- He had to modify it slightly to adjust the amount that was going to be spent for PBIS incentives to go towards the Chrome Book lab. That \$1,000 allocated for the PBIS will come out of the general school fund.

We are on track with spending with our Land Trust this year. We can't carry over more than 10%. We will have about \$1,400 left over.

Review assessment data for 2016/2017

Carolee and Mr. Weller presented the spring data. We have seen a lot of growth across grade levels in both reading and math. The teachers spend a lot of time looking at individual student data and planning ways to teach to meet the needs of each student.

Other Business:

Cell tower Money

We receive about \$1,000 from other schools that have cell towers. Mr. Weller would like to use it for PBIS incentives and staff morale. It was unanimously agreed to use it as Mr. Weller sees fit.

Staff Changes

Mrs. Logan, and Mrs. Brown will be leaving. Ms. Thompson and Ms. Jenkins will be moving to 2nd Grade. We've hired a teacher for 3rd grade and are interviewing for a 1st grade position. Mrs. Stocking will be leaving as our art teacher and we will be hiring a new one.

Other changes for next year:

Lunch will change and have recess first, and then students will come in and eat after recess. 1st grade will have the first lunch. 2nd and 4th grades will eat lunch together and 3rd and 5th grades will have lunch together.

Mr. Weller talked about plans for next year to include some enrichment activities before or after school. Teachers will receive a stipend to be able to offer various activities through out the year. We haven't worked out exactly how that will look, but we want to provide that opportunity. Cindy suggested a running club or something similar.

Also looking at a Brilliant Bengal award. It would have various criteria for students to complete to receive recognition for going above and beyond what is required.

The parking lot will be getting a make over this summer to allow a better and safer pick-up and drop-off. Parents will have to be trained at the beginning of the year to make sure they follow the rules. The signs that the school has in the parking lot to pull forward have been helpful.

Michelle suggested having a parent volunteer or safety patrol student stand in the Kindergarten area to help get kids into the building when they are late and can't get in through the Kindergarten door.
