REVIEW LAND TRUST PROGRESS and 15-16 FINAL REPORT- BJ passed out Final Report for 2015-2016 school year. All final amounts were reported on this form. REVIEW NEW CANYONS DISTRICT VISION AND MISSION- Everyone was given a copy of the new Vision, Mission, Values, Tenets and Indicators of the Canyons School District to review. Currently our district's graduation rate is around 80%.

DIGITAL CITIZENSHIP REVIEW- Handout passed out describing Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship. The SCC is charged with discussing how to create a safe technology environment for our students. Filters are in place to protect our students. Certain websites are completely blocked and then some are allowed at certain grade levels and not others. Safesharetv allows You Tube videos to be shown without all the additional videos or ads popping up. Students are taught what to do if something inappropriate pops up when they are using the computer- turn the screen off and immediately tell a teacher, parent or adult. Jennifer Davis is our trainer and updates the staff on Internet safety monthly. She will also be available during Parent Teacher Conferences to discuss internet safety with parents. We will

have a 1-1 ratio of technology for students 3rd-5th grade. Ipad cart was purchased for 1st and 2nd grade to share.

IDLE FREE- Dr. Briscoe (Superintendent)- Our district is an idle-free district. What kind of promotion can we do to remind parents to be idle free? We can publish in weekly email and Rayna can publish in PTA newsletter.
