VOTE ON BYLAWS

Amber Mowzeleski motioned to reaffirm Bylaws, Maryann Zenger seconded it. We voted to keep bylaws, unchanged.

CULTURAL NIGHT FEEDBACK

Everyone agreed that this was the most fun cultural night yet, a huge success. It worked much better to have the grades work together also. There hasn't been any negative feedback from the volunteers. The food drive was successful also, we raised about \$150 and filled the 4 barrels. We also made over \$200 on spirit wear sales that night.

Rayna asked whether we should keep it or do something different?

We love the idea of making it more of a community event, rather than limit it to the school. Some older neighbors came and enjoyed the night, hearing about it from flyers or possibly the article in the journal.

Several people, including Mr. Weller voiced the

importance of continuing cultural night. We discussed the need to incorporate the ethnicities of the students and their family cultures and traditions.

Rayna brought up the idea of pushing it out further to avoid bad weather and also to avoid other conflicts. Everyone felt moving it to April was a good idea.

FUNDRAISER

We discussed the following questions: should we keep an A-thon? Should we do an un-fundraiser? Some said that in the past this approach was not successful. People contribute more if the kids do something. Several member voiced that they like their kids to learn while doing the fundraiser.

Mr Weller suggested a read-a-thon. Kids get pledges based on how much they read over 2 weeks. The kids log their minutes.

Gathering the prizes is the most tedious part of the fundraiser. We discussed how to simplify the prizes, such as giving out free hall passes or first in line passes that are free, rather than buying so many prizes. Prizes are good, but they aren't motivating except for the big prizes. We talked about incentives rather than objects, and then reward other top earners with something like a movie in the KIVA, or a limo ride with the principal to McDonalds.

We talked about doing a fun run or a carnival. No one volunteered to head either of those up. Later Mr. Weller said he would look into a carnival run by the school not

the PTA.

We make so much money from the a-thons, we don't want to do something else. Someone suggested a committee to come up with ideas rather than the whole group. Rayna will send out an email about a committee meeting for the fundraiser.

JERSEY MIKES

Shayla came to present our school with a huge check from our earnings from Jersey Mike spirit week. Mr. Weller, Rayna and Shayla posed for a picture with the check. We made \$1797.

DONUT DAY

Mr. Weller wants to introduce a reading aspect to donut morning. Read with your parents while you eat your donut. Bring a book from home to read together. Laurel suggested a book exchange: bring a book and take a book from a table in the lunchroom. We also talked about creating a math aspect to it, writing on the paper over the tables, or acrostic poems with D-O-N-U-T.

BOX TOPS

Rayna talked to Smiths about having a box for collecting box tops at the customer service desk, which they agreed to. Mr. Weller will do a mass mailing to let people know about the box top drop-off at Smiths. The flyer should let people know they can sign-up to have their fresh values card connected to Canyon View and Smiths will donate money to our school. LeAnn suggested hanging a flyer on the community board to advertise the drop off box at the desk.

OTHER

We reviewed the calendar of upcoming events:

Directory

year. Someone suggested adding emails to the directory, which works as long as the parents give permission to release their email addresses. We also need the parents' names in the directory. Unfortunately, Skyward excluded some parents or kids that wanted to be in the directory. We discussed using a different way to generate the directory. We need to gather the information during the registration process rather than after the year has started. Mr. Weller will add something in the registration packet that asks permission to use certain information in the directory and will create two lists: a yes and no list for the directory. The room parents expressed concern about being limited in their communication to the parents. Giving room parents personal information requires separate permission from the directory. Laurel has a room mom template that she can email to other room moms, asking for information.

Game Day take over

Laurel is not doing game day next year. Does someone else want to take it over? At least 30 kids come to every game day. It will take place in the KIVA since orchestra has moved to another room. Rayna will keep asking for volunteers to head it up. Someone suggested rotating who is in charge of it.

Amber Wilkins suggested putting a basket of trivia on each table during donut morning.
