-Review of safety procedures: our school does not have to make changes to our protocol because we had our safety procedures in place. Communication about procedures is age appropriate for students. We do have evacuation facility secured at the LDS church across and to the west from our school.

-The parking lot issue will be addressed in today's email. A sign has been purchased regarding the back parking lot for parking only. Students need to exit on the passenger side not the driver's side. Parents can volunteer to direct traffic initially to help people notice the new sign and follow safety procedures.

-Master schedule being developed for next year: 3, 4, 5th grades will all have separate lunches next year to benefit the students and the adults in the lunchroom environment.

-Student enrollment determines teacher allotment for each school. Our enrollment will probably continue to decrease and we will need to determine funding for a portion of our teachers. The school community council will continue to look at these issues, including land trust money.
