**Treasurer:** We have \$8244.00 remaining to use for this school year. Any request for purchases need to be in writing, and given to a board member one week in advance of the next meeting.

- **Radios for School** –Cami Stauffer’s radios that she is recommending have private radio frequency with there own charging station. These radios are \$154.00 a piece. (\$2600 total)  
Mr. Weller needs 17 radios to provide them to his teachers and would cost \$980.00 from Costco. After researching radios Marta Stott found that Costco radios are the most cost effective choice.  
Voted to move forward with Mr. Weller’s option.  
It was proposed to pay half with PTA money, but it was stated that the original proposal was to pay for all of it so we should vote on the original proposal and if it doesn’t pass then to propose to pay half of it with PTA money. The vote passed to pay for all of it with PTA money.
- How much to carry over for next year? - It was decided that \$5,000.00 would be a sufficient cushion to carry over.

**Volunteer Coordinator:** Since it has been decided that there will be no Christmas parties this year, Marta asked if we could use that day for the kids to pick their countries for cultural night and talk about Holidays in that particular country. Mr. Weller said that all the teachers have informed him of their plans for that day and don’t need parents to plan and fill time for that day. As for the cultural Christmas idea, we will address that idea next school year. Mr. Weller reassured that there are a lot of fun activities for the students and not to worry.

**Newsletter:** LeeAnn suggested that we should add names to the pictures of the “guess who” section.

**Memberships:** Still receiving new memberships. We are up to roughly 226 members.

**Reflections:** The counsel level of judging for those students whose art moved on in the nationwide PTA Reflections contest will be held at Butler Middle School next Tuesday @ 7:00. All who are interested are invited to attend.
