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Principal's Message - May 2017

Canyon View Families,

I want to thank each and every one of you for all your support, and for entrusting me with your children for the past two years. I am honored and feel so fortunate to have been given the opportunity to be part of the Canyon View Community. I have had some amazing experiences here and will cherish the memories and friendships I've made during this time. As I reflect on the last two years, I feel like we have worked hard and partied hard to ensure we are providing the best educational experience for our students. We have seen great academic growth across all grade levels and I believe it's the result of our focus and partnership with you as parents. Every decision we have made has been focused on what is best for students and how can we continue to improve. Some of these include:

- Road to Success a web based reading minute tracker which has shown an increase in the amount of time and books students are reading. We also have awarded students monthly with prizes for entering those minutes.
- Bengal Cub of the Month We have recognized two students from each class for standing out as leaders and improving their academic agility. They were invited and recognized at a celebratory breakfast with me.
- Reverse Lunch After seeing too many students not eating, throwing food away, having sick students in the office and disrupting academic time by problem solving issues on the playground, we decided to send students out to recess first then come in and eat. This has proven effective as we have seen a decrease in the amount of garbage thrown away daily, rarely do we see a sick student in the office during lunch and adults in the cafeteria help problem solve student issues and concerns so they return to class ready to learn.
- Brilliant Bengal Cub Awards This prestigious award will be given at our end of year assembly. Each grade level designed their own requirements for the awards and is meant to recognize students for going above and beyond their normal academic studies and searching for ways to enrich their educational experience.
- Parking Lot We were able to expand the parking lot to make it safer and more efficient for drop off and pick up. On average, we get all cars through the parking lot in seven to eight minutes.
- Technology With your help from the fundraiser and participation with spirit nights, we updated and increased technology throughout the building and met our goal of having each student in grades 3-5 having their own device in class to use. Each grade level K-2 has their own iPad cart to use and we will continue to increase those as well.
- Teacher Certification More than half of our teachers earned their Level 1 technology certification demonstrating their knowledge of how to incorporate technology in the classroom.

Again, it has been an absolute honor to have worked here and I look forward to continuing to serve your students in a different capacity in the future.



You can view it from utah (the sun will be over 90% eclipsed) or travel a few hours to view a TOTAL solar eclipse!! The only safe way to view the sun is through special-purpose solar filters, such as "eclipse glasses." Never just look at the sun directly or even through dark sunglasses. The sun will damage your eyes!










# **CUB CORNER**
